SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Cleveland Clinic's paid summer internship program provides high school students with engaging, real-world work experience and professional learning opportunities in clinical, nonclinical and advanced technology tracks:

Advanced Technology focuses on technological aspects of healthcare.

Non-Clinical (Louis Stokes) includes business-focused areas of healthcare.

Clinical focuses on patient facing areas such as applied medicine, nursing and more.

Selected students will be paid \$15 per hour for orientation and all hours worked.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the program, applicants will:

- Be in grades 9, 10, 11 or 12 at time of application.
- Be 15 or older by June 1, 2026.
- Demonstrate a strong interest in a healthcare career.
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale.
- Be a U.S. citizen, noncitizen national or legal permanent resident.
- Be able to attend the entire program from June 8 through July 28, 2026.
- Live and attend school in Cuyahoga, Geauga, Portage, Lake, Lorain, Medina, Stark or Summit counties.
- Louis Stokes Track residency requirements: Live in Bedford, Bedford Heights, Cleveland, Cleveland Heights, East Cleveland, Euclid, Garfield Heights, Maple Heights, Richmond Heights, South Euclid or Warrensville Heights.
